Ordinance No. 1391-2023

FOR PASSAGE December 4, 2023

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Community Development to apply for and accept a grant from the Ohio Department of Development for the Lead Safe Ohio Program; and authorizing the Director to enter into one or more contracts with various contractors, certified lead contractors, agencies, entities, or individuals to implement the grant.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Community Development is authorized to apply for and accept a grant in the approximate amount of \$4,942,000, and any other funds that may become available during the grant term from the Ohio Department of Development to conduct the Lead Safe Ohio Program; that the Director is authorized to file all papers and execute all documents necessary to receive the funds under the grant; and that the funds are appropriated for the purposes described in the Notice of Funding Availability from the Ohio Department of Development and the Program Allocations for the grant contained in the file described below.

Section 2. That the Notice of Funding Availability from the Ohio Department of Development and the Program Allocations for the grant, **File No. 1391-2023-A**, made a part of this ordinance as if fully rewritten, is approved in all respects and shall not be changed without additional legislative authority.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the Director of Community Development is authorized to extend the term of the grant during the grant term.

Section 4. That the Director of Community Development is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with various contractors, certified lead contractors, agencies, entities, or individuals to implement the grant as described in the file, including but not limited to, conducting lead abatement, cleaning, repairs, and renovation services such as window and door replacement in residential properties, congregate shelters and childcare facilities.

That, unless expressly prohibited by the grant agreement, under Section 5.

Section 108(b) of the Charter, the Director of Community Development may make

purchases under the grant agreement through cooperative arrangements with other

governmental agencies. The Director of Community Development may sign all

documents and do all things that are necessary to make the purchases, and may enter

into one or more contracts with the vendors selected through that cooperative process.

The contracts shall be paid from the fund or funds to which are credited any grant funds

accepted under this ordinance.

Section 6. That the costs of the contract or contracts or payments authorized

by this ordinance shall be paid from the fund or funds to which are credited the grant

proceeds accepted under this ordinance, and any other funds approved by the Director

of Finance.

That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to

Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period

allowed by law.
