AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Safety to enter into an agreement with Deccan International to acquire licenses and maintenance for software to be utilized by the Divisions of Fire and Emergency Medical Service to improve response times and overall operations by optimizing divisional resources and personnel, for a period of one year.

WHEREAS, since 2011, the Commissioner of Purchases and Supplies has acquired from Deccan International licenses and maintenance for certain essential decision-support software applications utilized by the Divisions of Fire and Emergency Medical Service to improve response times and overall operations by optimizing the deployment of divisional personnel and equipment resources (the "Software"), for annual costs less than \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, the cost to acquire licenses and maintenance for the Software for the current year will exceed \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. The Director of Public Safety is authorized to enter an agreement with Deccan International to acquire licenses and maintenance to implement, maintain, expand, and enhance the Software for a period of one year at a cost not to exceed \$56,881.

Section 2. That the costs of the licenses, maintenance and any associated expenditures shall be paid from Fund No. 01-1601-6612. (RQS 1601, RL 2025-72)

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
