temporary easements, permanent easements, and work agreements; to add any and all funds as authorized by

Director of Finance.

Description: East 18th Street from East 14th Street to Lakeside will be

repaired and resurfaced, approximate length 0.94 miles. The improvements include new roadway footprint; one lane in each direction with left turn lanes at major intersections and bike lanes. Work includes pavement milling, base removal, ADA Compliant ramps, and new 12-inch waterline from Central to Carnegie, Payne to Superior and

Rockwell intersection.
