AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. CT 3001 NF2014-005 with Aircraft Services International Inc., dba Menzies Aviation, for professional services to manage and operate an Airport-owned fuel storage and distribution facility known as the South Fuel Farm located at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 742-12, passed August 8, 2012, the Director of Port Control entered into Contract No. CT 3001 NF2014-005 with Aircraft Services International Inc., dba Menzies Aviation, for professional services to manage and operate an Airport-owned fuel storage and distribution facility known as the South Fuel Farm located at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 742-12 requires further legislation before exercising the first option to renew on this contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. CT 3001 NF2014-005 with Aircraft Services International Inc., dba Menzies Aviation, for professional services to manage and operate an Airportowned fuel storage and distribution facility known as the South Fuel Farm located at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport. This ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Ordinance No. 742-12 to exercise this option.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
