Ord. No. 549-2024

By Council Members Kazy and Griffin (by departmental request)

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Utilities to enter into one or more contracts with AT & T Corp. for professional services necessary to add new hardware, network and telecommunication services, for the various divisions of the Department of Public Utilities for a period of three years.

Estimated Cost: 1,212,399

Ord. No. 628-2024

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Utilities to enter into one or more requirement contracts without competitive bidding with Hach Company for laboratory supplies and chemicals needed for the proprietary equipment manufactured by the Hach Company, for the Division of Water, Department of Public Utilities, for a term of two years.
