EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Department of Port Control ("Department") is requesting authority to repeal Ordinance No. 828-2024, passed September 23, 2024, relating to the purchase of up to thirteen passenger boarding bridges at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport; and The Department of Port Control is requesting authority to determine the method of making the public improvement of designing and constructing up to thirteen passenger boarding bridges at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport; authorizing the Director of Port Control to enter into contracts for Design-Build or engineer-procure-construct services for the improvement.

Background/Purpose:

Ordinance No. 828-2024, passed September 23, 2024, authorized the Department of Port Control to enter into one or more standard contracts to purchase and install up to thirteen passenger boarding bridges.

During the drafting of the procurement documents, the Department determined it would be in the best interest of the project to utilize a design build contract. A design build contract will ensure that the project will be done in a timelier and cost-efficient manner.

Anticipated cost:

The estimated cost for these services is \$17,000,000.

Schedule or Term of Contract:

This request is for the design-build or engineer-procure-construct contract to begin upon the date of execution and, unless extended by the City or unless sooner canceled or terminated pursuant to the provisions thereof, shall terminate upon the Department Director's acceptance of completion of all required services.
