<u>Section 1.</u> That this Council declares its intent to vacate a portion of the following described real property:

West 6th Street

Situated in the City of Cleveland, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio and known as being part of Original Two Acre Lot No. 6, further described as follows:

Being all that portion of West 6th Street (99.00 feet wide) (formerly known as Bank Street) extending from the North line of West Lakeside Avenue (99.00 feet wide) northerly to that portion of West 6th Street vacated by City of Cleveland ordinance 2030-97, passed March 2, 1998 as shown in the recorded Vacation Plat of part of West 6th Street in volume 293, page 29 of Cuyahoga County Map records.

<u>Section 2.</u> That this resolution is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
