## **Ordinance No. 600-2025**

#### AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Economic
Development to amend Agreement No. 50086
authorized by Ordinance No. 1235-95, passed
December 13, 1995, with the Village of Highland
Hills, to expand territory in the development area
to include the former House of Corrections site,
located on Millcreek Boulevard.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Economic Development is authorized to enter into an amendment to Agreement No. 50086 authorized by Ordinance No. 1235-95, passed December 13, 1995, with the Village of Highland Hills, to expand the territory in the development area to include the former House of Corrections site, located on Millcreek Boulevard, as depicted in **File No. 600-2025-A**. All other terms and conditions of this agreement shall remain the same.

Section 2. That the cost of the amendment shall be paid from funds approved by the Director of Economic Development.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the amendment to the above-referenced contract shall be prepared by the Director of Law.

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
