## **Executive Summary**

The Department of Port Control ("Department") is requesting authority to amend contract MA RC2019-87 with Nachurs Alpine Solutions, LLC to provide potassium acetate (Alpine RF-11) and sodium formate at a recalculated price; and to extend for a period of six months.

# **Background/Purpose:**

The Department of Port Control ("DPC") is required to maintain all taxiways and runways free and clear of accumulations of snow and ice during the winter season. To ensure these safe operations the chemicals Alpine RF- 11 (Potassium Acetate) and Sodium Formate are used for deicing purposes.

#### Justification:

Contract No. MA RC2019-87 expires on November 24, 2023. In order to bridge the gap between the current contract expiring and a new contract being executed, DPC is requesting a six-month extension, and allowing Nachurs to recalculate their pricing. Deicing chemicals are a necessity for the safety and operation of the airfield during the winter season.
