

Ordinance No. 203-2026

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Consenting and approving the issuance of a permit for the Cleveland 10-Miler on April 25, 2026, managed by Hermes Sports & Events.

FOR PASSAGE
February 23, 2026

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That pursuant to Section 411.06 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio 1976, this Council consents to and approves the holding of the Cleveland 10-Miler on April 25, 2026, managed by Hermes Sports & Events; START: Eastend parking lot entrance of upper Edgewater - head west on upper Edgewater Drive towards Cliff Drive - continue on Cliff Drive to Edgewater Drive - right onto Edgewater Drive - right onto Harborview Drive to West 115th Street - right onto Lake Avenue - turn around at Belle Avenue (Lakewood Park) - left on West 115th Street - right on Harborview Drive - left to Edgewater Drive - left to West 103rd Street/Cliff Drive - continue down to Edgewater Drive/Cliff intersection - hop onto path – lining Shoreway Highway - continue on path to Lower Edgewater roundabout - continue straight on path heading east towards Whiskey Island - turnaround at Whiskey Island - return on path – at roundabout veer right on path – FINISH: on path along Lakefront – ending at Edgewater Beach House; provided that the applicant sponsor shall meet all the requirements of Section 411.05 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976. Streets may be closed as determined by the Chief of Police and safety forces as may be necessary in order to protect the participants in the event. Said permit shall further provide that the City of Cleveland shall be fully indemnified from any and all liability resulting from the issuance of the same, to the extent and in form satisfactory to the Director of Law.

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
