

Ordinance No. 267-2022

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to exercise the second option to renew Contract No. PS 2020-204 with Runway Safe, Inc. to provide professional services for the inspection, maintenance, and repair of three Engineered Materials Arresting Systems, for Cleveland Hopkins International Airport and Burke Lakefront Airport.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 337-2020, passed June 3, 2020, the Director of Port Control entered into Contract No. PS 2020-204 with Runway Safe, Inc. to provide professional services for the inspection, maintenance, and repair of three Engineered Materials Arresting Systems, for Cleveland Hopkins International Airport and Burke Lakefront Airport; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 337-2020 requires further legislation before exercising the second option to renew on this contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to exercise the second option to renew Contract No. PS 2020-204 with Runway Safe, Inc. to provide professional services for the inspection, maintenance, and repair of three Engineered Materials Arresting Systems, for Cleveland Hopkins International Airport and Burke Lakefront Airport. This ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Ordinance No. 337-2020 to exercise this option.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
