Project Summary

Neighborhood Health Care, Incorporated and/or Designee, operating under the name Neighborhood Family Practice, is requesting a \$500,000 UDAG Repayment Fund loan to partially finance costs associated with demolition; construction, renovation; environmental assessments/remediation; infrastructure; soft costs; equipment, furniture, fixtures; I.T. costs; landscaping; EV charging stations; signage and other eligible costs located at 13027 Lorain Avenue, Cleveland, OH 44111 in Ward 16 ("Project Site"). As part of the relocation and expansion project, the organization will be able to expand dental services at the project site. In addition, the new location will accommodate a pharmacy, which currently does not exist in the Jefferson-Puritas neighborhood due to the closure of two CVS pharmacies and a Rite Aid.

This piece of legislation will allow the City of Cleveland's Director of Economic Development to enter into a \$500,000 UDAG Fund Loan agreement with the Neighborhood Health Care, Incorporated and / or Designee.
