

# Ordinance No. 800-2025

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1167-2024, passed January 13, 2025, relating to a contract with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc., to provide professional services for on-call planning services.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1167-2024, passed January 13, 2025, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That the Director of City Planning is authorized to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. PS 2024-0030 with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. to provide professional services for on-call planning services. This ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Ordinance No. 1200-2023 to exercise this option and shall not exceed ~~\$100,000~~ \$200,000 for the first option year.

Section 2. That existing Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1167-2024, passed January 13, 2025, is repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
