AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Section 2 of Ordinance 266-2024, passed March 4, 2024, relating to the agreement with Burten, Bell Carr Development Corporation for the 2023 Youth Football Recreation Program.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance 266-2024, passed March 4, 2024, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2. That the cost of said contract shall be in an amount not to exceed \$17,297.00 and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 188 using the fund and project number from the following Ward:

<u>Ward</u>	<u>Amount</u>	<u>Project Number</u>
Ward 4	\$17,297.00	G24648 <u>G24647</u>

Section 2. That the existing Section 2 of Ordinance 266-2024, passed March 4, 2024, is repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
