AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of the Department Economic Development to enter into agreement with Northeast Ohio Neighborhood Health Services, Inc., for the New Eastside Market Project through the use of Ward 7 Casino Revenue Funds and Neighborhood Equity Funds.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the Director of the Department of Economic Development is hereby authorized to enter into agreement effective December 1, 2017 with Northeast Ohio Neighborhood Health Services, Inc., for the New Eastside Market Project for the public purpose of promoting economic revitalization and new job creation in the city of Cleveland through the use of Ward 7 Casino Revenue Funds and Neighborhood Equity Funds.

Section 2. That the cost of said contract shall be in an amount not to exceed \$315,615.42 and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 188, and Fund No. 10 SF 166.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the Director of Law shall prepare and approve said contract and that the contract shall contain such terms and provisions as he deems necessary to protect the City's interest.

<u>Section 4.</u> That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
