

# Ordinance No. 786-2025

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation to enter into a grant agreement with Ohio City Incorporated to provide program support for Near West Recreation youth programs.

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WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation is authorized to enter into a grant agreement with Ohio City Incorporated to provide program support for Near West Recreation youth programs, as set forth in Ohio City Incorporated’s grant proposal. This grant agreement shall be entered into for the 2025-2026 program year.

Section 2. The agreement shall be certified in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 and from Fund 01001, Dept. 4503, Subfund/Approp. 630, Object Code 6380.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
