**East 66<sup>th</sup> Place Intent to Vacate**

Description: Situated in the City of Cleveland, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio as known as being a portion of East 66<sup>th</sup> Place (12.00 feet wide) in the Samuel B. Strang's Subdivision of part of Original One Hundred Acre Lot Number 341 as shown by the recorded plat in Volume 3 of Maps, Page 46 of Cuyahoga County Records, further described as follows:

Being all that portion of East 66<sup>th</sup> Place (12.00 feet wide) extending from the South line of Lexington Avenue (60.00 feet wide) to the North line of Quimby Avenue (60.00 feet wide).

Purpose: The Cleveland Public Library is in the process of designing a new Hough branch that will be built on property that they intend to acquire from the City Land Bank at the corner of E 66<sup>th</sup> Street and Lexington Avenue. There is an alleyway called E. 66<sup>th</sup> Place that runs north and south between Lexington and Quimby Avenues. The parcels that Cleveland Public Library intends to acquire are located on either side of E. 66<sup>th</sup> Place. The alley is no longer being used for access and is un-improved.

A consent form acknowledging approval of this request has been signed from the Council Member.
