

Ordinance No.1370-2019 (As Amended)

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE
Authorizing the Director of Public Utilities to enter into one or more requirement contracts without competitive bidding with Wadsworth-Slawson, Inc. dba Wadsworth Solutions Northeast to complete the final phase of the building automation upgrade at 1201 Lakeside Avenue, for the Department of Public Utilities.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That this Council determines that the within commodities and services are non-competitive and cannot be secured from any source other than Wadsworth-Slawson, Inc. dba Wadsworth Solutions Northeast. Therefore, the Director of Public Utilities is authorized to make one or more written requirement contracts with Wadsworth-Slawson, Inc. dba Wadsworth Solutions Northeast, in an estimated amount of \$235,995.00, for a period to be determined by the Director, to complete the final phase of the building automation upgrade at 1201 Lakeside Avenue, which will include the purchase of proprietary equipment and services necessary to replace the remaining obsolete components of the Barber Coleman Network 8000 building automation system, including installation, to be purchased by the Commissioner of Purchases and Supplies on a unit basis, for the Department of Public Utilities.

Section 2. That the costs of the contract or contracts shall be charged against the proper appropriation accounts and the Director of Finance shall certify the amount of any purchase under the contract, each of which purchases shall be made on order of the Commissioner of Purchases and Supplies by a delivery order issued against the contract or contracts and certified by the Director of Finance. Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
