WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 702-16 requires further legislation before exercising

the option to renew on this contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the

usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the Director of Public Utilities is authorized to exercise the

option to renew Contract No. CT 2004 PS 2017-4 for an additional two years with

Brilliency, Inc. at a cost not to exceed \$80,000, payable from Fund No 58 SF 001. This

ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Ordinance No. 702-

16 to exercise this option. (RQS 2004, RL 2018-65)

<u>Section 2.</u> That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


