2025-2026 Grinding of Pavement

DIVISION: Street Maintenance

ORDINANCE NO: 233-2025

DESCRIPTION: This legislation authorizes the Director of Public Works to enter into a Public Improvement Requirement contract for the grinding of pavement for local resurfacing of City streets.

LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE: This legislation is necessary for the 2025-2026 grinding season and to ensure the safety of public traveling on City streets.

CONTRACT TERMS: One (1) year with two (2) additional one-year renewal options at the discretion of the Director of Public Works.

- \$2,200,000.00

CURRENT CONTRACT: Contract No. CT-7016-PIRC-2022-004
One year with two one-year options to renew – 2022-2025 grinding season

- Total spent = \$1,624,698.65 as of 11/29/24

CONTRACT EXPIRES: September 7, 2025

FUNDING SOURCE: Operating Budget, Roads & Bridge Bonds, Restricted Income Tax, NEF Funds, and additional funding sources as deemed appropriate by the Director of Finance.
