SUBJECT: Ordinance No. 881-2019 Authorizing the Director of Public Safety to donate a vintage former Police boat known as "Jack F. Delaney" to the Cleveland Police Museum; and to enter into an agreement to make the donation **(as amended)**

DATE: August 21, 2019

Ordinance No. 881-2019, if passed by Council, would authorize the Director of Public Safety the former Police boat, the "Jack F. Delaney", to the Cleveland Police Museum.

The *Jack F. Delaney* has been out of service for several years and is currently being leased by the City to the Cleveland Police Museum. This Ordinance would authorize the Director of Public Safety to enter into an agreement with the Museum to donate the boat to the Museum. This will enable them to make repairs to the boat as deemed necessary and to move the boat to different location(s). The boat has been deemed no longer needed or not suitable for the use of any department or office of the City in accordance with C.O. 181.19.

Per amendment to this Ordinance, the Department of Public Safety will make arrangements to deliver the boat to the Cleveland Police Museum.
