AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Section 5 of Ordinance No 1168-2024, passed October 28, 2024, relating to a grant agreement with Jonad Properties, LLC or its designee.

FOR PASSAGE
November 4, 2024

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 5 of Ordinance No. 1168-2024, passed October 28, 2024, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 5. That the costs of the grant shall not exceed an amount of \$150,000 and shall be paid from Fund Nos. ~~01-9501-6926~~ 01-001-9997 and 10 SF 166. (RQS 9501, RL 2024-120)

Section 2. That existing Section 5 of Ordinance No. 1168-2024, passed October 28, 2024, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
