

Ordinance No. 310-2021

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to employ one or more professional consultants to enter into one or more management agreements to provide maintenance, operation and management services for City-owned parking lots located in North Coast Harbor, for a period of five years, with one option to renew for an additional five-year period, which shall require additional legislative authority.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to employ by contract or contracts one or more consultants or one or more firms of consultants for the purpose of supplementing the regularly employed staff of the several departments of the City of Cleveland in order to provide professional services necessary to enter into one or more management agreements to provide maintenance, operation and management services for three City-owned parking lots located in North Coast Harbor, for a period of five years, with one option to renew for an additional five-year period. The option to renew may not be exercised without additional legislative authority.

The selection of the consultants for the services shall be made by the Board of Control on the nomination of the Director of Port Control from a list of qualified consultants available for employment as may be determined after a full and complete canvass by the Director of Port Control for the purpose of compiling a list. The compensation to be paid for the services shall be fixed by the Board of Control. The contract or contracts authorized shall be prepared by the Director of Law, approved by the Director of Port Control, and certified by the Director of Finance.

Section 2. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to accept funds generated from the three North Coast Harbor parking lots to be deposited in Fund No. 10 SF 113.

Section 3. That the cost of contract or contracts authorized shall be paid from the fees collected from the operation of the three parking lots located in North Coast Harbor, which are deposited into Fund No. 10 SF 113.

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
