## **Ordinance No. 753-2023**

#### AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Human Resources to enter into one or more contracts in order to provide professional services necessary to administer and provide medical reimbursement accounts and dependent care accounts under Internal Revenue Code Section 125 for City of Cleveland employees, for a period up to one year, with two one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Human Resources.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Human Resources is authorized to enter into one or more contracts in order to provide professional services necessary to administer and provide medical reimbursement accounts and dependent care accounts under Internal Revenue Code Section 125 for City of Cleveland employees, for a period up to one year, with two one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Human Resources.

The selection of the carriers shall be made by the Board of Control on the nomination of the Director of Human Resources from a list of qualified carriers as may be determined after a full and complete canvass by the Director of Human Resources for the purpose of compiling a list. The cost to be paid for the contracts shall be fixed by the Board of Control. The contract or contracts authorized shall be prepared by the Director of Law, approved by the Director of Human Resources, and certified by the Director of Finance.

Section 2. That the cost of the contract or contracts authorized shall be paid from Fund No. 70 SF 201, RQS 0402, RLA 2023-63.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
