WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the Director of Community Development is authorized to enter

into one or more agreements with United Way of Greater Cleveland, as the lead partner

organization, to implement a program to provide access to legal services for covered

individuals in eviction proceedings under Cleveland Codified Ordinance Section 375.12,

Legal Representation in Housing Court.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the agreement or agreements shall be prepared by the Director

of Law.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the cost of the agreement or agreements shall not exceed

\$500,000 and shall be paid from Fund No. 01-8006-6320. (RQS 8006, RL 2025-52)

<u>Section 4</u>. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


