AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE
Authorizing the Director of the Department of Community Development to enter into an agreement with Burten, Bell, Carr Development Inc. for the Food Distribution Program through the use of Ward 4 Casino Revenue Funds, and repealing Ordinance No. 1209-2021, passed November 29, 2021.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of the Department of Community Development is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement effective as of November 5, 2021, with Burten, Bell, Carr Development Inc., for the Food Distribution Program for the public purpose of providing food cards to low/moderate income residents residing in the city of Cleveland through the use of Ward 4 Casino Revenue Funds.

Section 2. That the cost of said contract shall be in an amount not to exceed \$15,000 and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 188.

Section 3. That the Director of Law shall prepare and approve said contract and that the contract shall contain such terms and provisions as the Director deems necessary to protect the City's interest.

Section 4. That Ordinance No. 1209-2021, passed November 29, 2021, is hereby repealed.

Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
