AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Ordinance No. 1780-05, passed January 9, 2006, as amended by various ordinances, by inserting new Section 11a.

FOR PASSAGE
February 9, 2026

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 1780-05, passed January 9, 2006, as amended by Ordinance No. 766-11, passed June 6, 2011, Ordinance No. 123-13, passed March 18, 2013, and Ordinance No. 195-15, passed March 16, 2015, is amended by inserting new Section 11a to read as follows:

Section 11a. That the Director of Development is authorized to use up to \$219,120.00 from the Neighborhood Equity Fund, Fund No. 10-166 Project No. D25402 for eligible projects within the TIF district; such funds shall be used in the same manner as TIF proceeds may be used under this ordinance. The Director of Finance is authorized to certify such amount for this purpose.

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
