

Ordinance No. 1239-2023

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Section 38 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March 29, 2021, as amended, relating to salaries for various classifications.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 38 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March 29, 2021, as amended by Ordinance No. 94-2022, passed March 21, 2022, Ordinance No. 1281-2022, passed December 5, 2022, Ordinance No. 776-2023, passed July 12, 2023, and Ordinance No. 901-2023, passed August 16, 2023, is amended to read as follows:

Section 38. That the salaries in the following classifications shall be fixed by the appointing authority in accordance with the schedule appearing after each classification:

Section 2. That existing Section 38 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March 29, 2021, as amended by Ordinance No. 94-2022, passed March 21, 2022, Ordinance No. 1281-2022, passed December 5, 2022, Ordinance No. 776-2023, passed July 12, 2023, and Ordinance No. 901-2023, passed August 16, 2023, is repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
