# Ordinance No. 1304-2023

FOR PASSAGE November 13, 2023

#### AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Approving the collective bargaining agreement with the Laborers International Union of North America (LiUNA), Local 860 (Non-Supervisory and Supervisory); and to amend Sections 26 and 27 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March 29, 2021, as amended, relating to salaries for various classifications.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That under division (B) of Section 4117.10 of the Revised Code, this Council approves the collective bargaining agreement with the Laborers International Union of North America (LiUNA), Local 860 (Non-Supervisory), under the terms contained in File No. 1304-2023-A, for the period from April 1, 2022 through March 31, 2025, and which provides, among other things, for equity increases and an increase in the salaries and wages for members of the bargaining unit under the following schedule:

Section 2. That under division (B) of Section 4117.10 of the Revised Code, this Council approves the collective bargaining agreement with the Laborers International Union of North America (LiUNA), Local 860 (Supervisory), under the terms contained in the file mentioned above, for the period from April 1, 2022 through March 31, 2025, and which provides, among other things, for equity increases and an increase in the salaries and wages for members of the bargaining unit under the following schedule:
