Executive Summary

The Department of Port Control requests authority to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. PS2025-0082 with Team Hallahan, LLC to provide professional services, including lobbying services to assist with legislative, regulatory, and policy issues with the Department of Port Control.

Background/Purpose:

The Department of Port Control is requesting legislation to authorize the purchase of professional services, including lobbying services to assist with legislative, regulatory, and policy issues with the Cleveland Airport System.

Scope of Work:

This contract will provide professional services, including lobbying services to assist with legislative, regulatory, and policy issues with the Cleveland Airport System.

Justification/Urgency:

This legislation is needed to provide the Department of Port Control with lobbying services for all federal agencies related to aviation and transportation for the purpose of assisting with a multitude of federal legislative, regulatory, and policy issues. Services provided will include, but are not limited to, assisting with developing relationships with elected and appointed federal officials, particularly TSA, CBP, FAA, DOT, and NTSB; assisting with developing an action plan to advance federal legislative and policy positions favorable to DPC; assisting with the preparation of federal funding requests and drafting supporting materials; and monitoring and regularly reporting on legislation, congressional hearings, regulations, and policy trends of interest.
