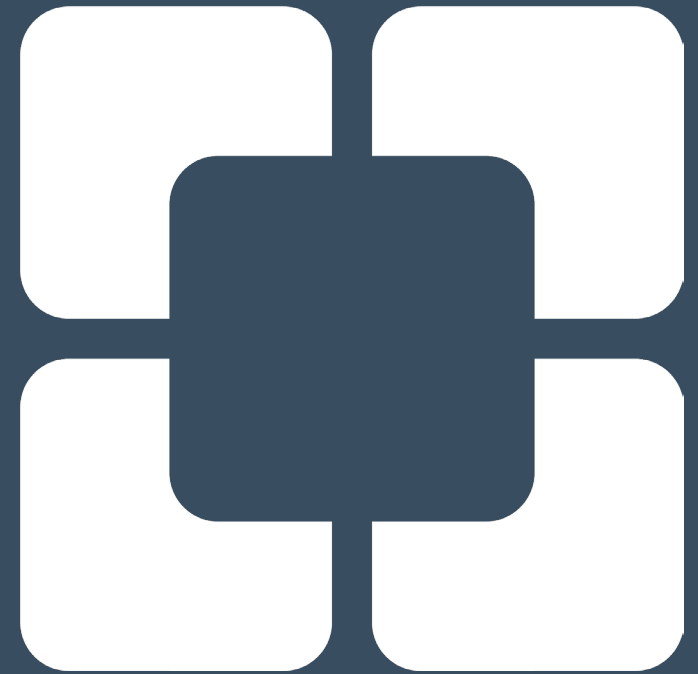

Impacts of Violence Against Healthcare Workers

- Trauma Endured by Caregivers + Witnesses
- Showing Up to Work but Not Being Fully Present
- Missed Work for Physical/Psychological Recovery
- Caregivers Leaving the Healthcare System
- Caregivers Pursuing New Career Outside Healthcare

Shaping + Supporting Safety Policies

- **FEDERAL:** Save Healthcare Workers Act (H.R. 3178/S.1600) Bill
- **STATE:** Healthcare Workplace Safety Act (Ohio H.B. 452)
- **LOCAL:** City of Cleveland Ordinance No. 54-74, Section 621.07
- **RECOMMENDATION:** Amend to include healthcare workers
