To authorize an amendment to Contract No. CT 6007 PS2017-251 with Cuyahoga County for the County Sheriff's Department relating to housing and providing services for City prisoners. The amendment will increase the per diem rate from \$99.00 to \$143.00 per day beginning January 1, 2026; will allow for automatic 2.5% annual increases to the per diem rate thereafter; will allow for increases in the per diem rate that exceeds the annual 2.5% increase if the County provides the City documentation that justifies such an additional increase in the City's reasonable discretion; and will amend other provisions of the Agreement relating to the booking and charging of City prisoners including the implementation of new timelines for charging prisoners and requirements that City prosecutors and detectives will be present and available between 8:00 AM and midnight to meet charging deadlines
