Union Avenue Rehabilitation, PID 111338

Purpose:

This Department requests legislation to grant consent to the ODOT to construct the improvement on Union Avenue from Broadway Avenue to Kinsman Road, PID 111338; to authorize the Director of Capital Projects to apply for and accept any gifts or grants from any public or private entity; to cause payment to ODOT for local share in an estimated amount of \$1,276,833; to enter into one or more agreements necessary to make the improvement; from any and all funds as authorized by Director of Finance.

Description:

The City has arranged for the preparation of construction plans and specifications, including engineering reports within the 3.2 mile project limit. ODOT will arrange the project sale, award to the lowest responsible bidder and provide construction supervision and administration of the improvement. The improvement includes asphalt milling, pavement base repair, asphalt resurfacing, installation of ADA compliant ramps, minor curb, walk and drive replacement and new pavement marking and signing. Safety grant application was filed in March 2019 and notice of award is pending in June which includes bike lanes.
