

Executive Summary
Home for Every Neighbor

Background/Purpose:

Authorizing the Director of Public Health to enter into one or more contracts with Downtown Cleveland Alliance, The Centers, and other partners in homeless services for the purpose of continuing “A Home for Every Neighbor” Program, direct-to-housing encampment resolution in the City of Cleveland to bring people off the streets and into housing.

Budget:

Total \$1,920,000

Rental Subsidies: \$1,200,000

Outreach and case management: \$370,000

High needs/Clinical case management: \$200,000

Flex Fund to meet crucial needs of clients: \$150,000

Duration: 1- year, with 1 option to renew for a period up to one year.

Funding Source: General Fund
