WHEREAS, this Council objected to the transfer of location of a D5 Liquor Permit to Suite 55, LLC, 1105 Carnegie Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44115, Permit No. 10009264 by Resolution No. 1314-2025 adopted by the Council on October 20, 2025; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to withdraw its objection to the above transfer and consents to said transfer; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That objection to the transfer of location of D5 Liquor Permit to Suite 55, LLC, 1105 Carnegie Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44115, Permit No. 10009264, be and the same is hereby withdrawn and Resolution No. 1314-2025, containing such objection, be and the same is hereby repealed and that this Council consents to the immediate transfer thereof.

Section 2. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
