

Ordinance No. 844-17

**Council Members Keane and Kelley
(by departmental request)**

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to exercise the first option to renew Phase I and Phase II concessions under Contract No. 67743 with Airmall Cleveland, Inc. fka BAA USA, Inc., for the design, construction, lease and management of all retail merchandise and food and beverage concessions facilities at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport; and to amend the contract to change certain terms of Phase I of the contract.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 1850-06, passed April 2, 2007, the Director of Port Control entered into Contract No. 67743 with Airmall Cleveland, Inc. fka BAA USA, Inc. ("Airmall") for the design, construction, lease and management of all retail merchandise and food and beverage concessions facilities at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1850-06 requires further legislation before exercising the first option to renew on this contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. 67743 for an additional five years with Airmall for the design, construction, lease and management of all retail merchandise and food and beverage concessions facilities at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport.

Section 2. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to enter into an amendment to Contract No. 67743 with Airmall to extend Phase I until January 15, 2019, to be coterminous with Phase II which expires on January 15, 2019, at no cost to the City.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
