

# Resolution No. 300-2019

## **AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION**

Designating Newton Avenue between East 97<sup>th</sup> Street and East 101<sup>st</sup> Street as a residential permit parking area for residents.

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WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety has received verified petitions by residents living in eighty percent (80%) of the living units in the area of Newton Avenue between East 97<sup>th</sup> Street and East 101<sup>st</sup> Street; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety has completed a survey of the above mentioned street and the surrounding areas, has held a public hearing, and has determined that this one-way residential street is surrounded by many commercial developments, therefore widespread use of available curbside parking spaces by non-resident vehicles results in a lack of nearby curbside parking for residents; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety has therefore determined that Newton Avenue between East 97<sup>th</sup> Street and East 101<sup>st</sup> Street is eligible for residential permit parking and has recommended to Council that it designate said street as a residential permit parking area; and

WHEREAS, Council Member Basheer Jones concurs in the Director's recommendation; and

WHEREAS, Newton Avenue between East 97<sup>th</sup> Street and East 101<sup>st</sup> Street has otherwise met the objective criteria set forth in Chapter 461 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of public peace, property, health, or safety, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That this Council hereby designates Newton Avenue between East 97<sup>th</sup> Street and East 101<sup>st</sup> Street a residential permit parking area, twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week.

Section 2. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it received the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
