AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Consenting and approving the issuance of a permit for the Hofbräuhaus Run on August 2, 2026, managed by Hermes Sports & Events.

FOR PASSAGE
March 9, 2026

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That pursuant to Section 411.06 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio 1976, this Council consents to and approves the holding of the Hofbräuhaus Run on August 2, 2026; START: East 17th Street head north - left on Payne Avenue - left on East 13th Street - left on Euclid Avenue - continue in the Eastbound Lane - merge left into the Westbound Lane at the East 100th Street and Euclid Avenue intersection - turn left onto East 101st Street - cross Chester Avenue and continue north - turn right onto Mt Sinai Drive - turn left onto East 105th Street - turn left on Martin Luther King Jr Drive - turn left on N Marginal Drive - TURNAROUND: N Marginal Drive - turn right on Martin Luther King Jr Drive - continue south - turn right onto East 105th Street - turn right onto Mt Sinai Drive - turn left onto East 101st Street - turn right onto Euclid Avenue and continue in Westbound Lane - turn right onto East 17th Street - FINISH: East 17th Street (Same as Start); provided that the applicant sponsor shall meet all the requirements of Section 411.05 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976. Streets may be closed as determined by the Chief of Police and safety forces as may be necessary in order to protect the participants in the event. Said permit shall further provide that the City of Cleveland shall be fully indemnified from any and all liability resulting from the issuance of the same, to the extent and in form satisfactory to the Director of Law.

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
