### Ord. No. 228-2025

By Council Members Polensek and Griffin (by departmental request)

An emergency ordinance to amend Sections 630.01 and 630.02 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, as amended by Ordinance No. 574-18, passed May 14, 2018, relating to criminal activity nuisances declared and action to abate nuisances and cost of enforcement.

### Ord. No. 330-2025

By Council Members Polensek and Griffin (by departmental request)

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Safety to enter into one or more agreements with Case Western Reserve University for professional services necessary to continue implementation of a data collection and analysis process, for the Division of Police, Department of Public Safety, for a period of one year with two one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Public Safety.
