

Ordinance No. 1183-2019

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Safety to apply for and accept a grant from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation for the Safety Intervention Grant Program; and authorizing the Director to enter into one or more contracts without competitive bidding with Stryker Medical for the purchase of up to two Stryker power load cot fasteners, for the Division of Emergency Medical Service, Department of Public Safety.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Safety is authorized to apply for and accept a grant in the amount of \$40,000, and any other funds that may become available during the grant term from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation for the Safety Intervention Grant Program; that the Director is authorized to file all papers and execute all documents necessary to receive the funds under the grant; and that the funds are appropriated for the purposes described in the grant package for the grant contained in the file described below.

Section 2. That the grant package for the grant, File No. _____, made a part of this ordinance as if fully rewritten, including the obligation of the City of Cleveland to provide cash matching funds in the sum of \$14,149.10 from Fund No. 01-6004-6380, is approved in all respects and shall not be changed without additional legislative authority. (RQS 6004, RL 2019-85)

Section 3. That this Council determines that the within commodities are non-competitive and cannot be secured from any source other than Stryker Medical. Therefore the Director of Public Safety is authorized to make one or more written contracts with Stryker Medical on the basis of its proposal dated May 6, 2019, for the purchase of two Stryker power load cot fasteners, to be purchased by the Commissioner of Purchases and Supplies, for the Division of Emergency Medical Service, Department of Public Safety.

Section 4. That the costs of the contract or contracts authorized by this ordinance shall be paid from the fund or funds to which are credited the grant proceeds accepted under this ordinance and the cash match.

Section 5. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by
