AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE
Authorizing the Director of Economic
Development to enter into a grant agreement
with Manufacturing Works, formerly known as
Westside Industrial Retention and Expansion
Network – WIRE-net, or its designee, to provide
economic development assistance to finance the
administration of the Cleveland Industrial
Retention Initiative Program.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the
usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Economic Development is authorized to enter
into a grant agreement with Manufacturing Works, formerly known as Westside
Industrial Retention and Expansion Network – WIRE-net, or its designee, to provide
economic development assistance to finance the administration of the Cleveland
Industrial Retention Initiative (“CIRI”) Program.

Section 2. That the costs of the grant shall not exceed \$499,870 and shall be
paid from Fund No. 17 SF 652, RQS 9501, RL 2019-86.

Section 3. That the Director of Law is authorized to prepare the grant
agreement and other documents as may be appropriate to complete the transaction.

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and,
provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to
Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by
the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period
allowed by law.
