

Ordinance No. 81-2019**Council Members:** Cleveland and Kelley

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Port Control to exercise the third option to renew Contract No. CT 3001 LS 2014-28 with United Airlines, Inc. to provide for the use and occupancy of office and warehouse space located in the South Cargo Facility at 6090 Cargo Road at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport for the purposes of operating an air cargo facility.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 1515-13, passed November 25, 2013, the Director of Port Control entered into Contract No. CT 3001 LS 2014-28 with United Airlines, Inc. for the use and occupancy of office and warehouse space located in the South Cargo Facility at 6090 Cargo Road at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport for the purposes of operating an air cargo facility; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1515-13 requires further legislation before exercising the third option to renew on this contract; and

WHEREAS, for the use of the Leased premises, United Airlines, Inc. shall pay the City an annual fee as specified in the contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to exercise the third option to renew Contract No. CT 3001 LS 2014-28 for an additional year with United Airlines, Inc. for the use and occupancy of office and warehouse space located in the South Cargo Facility at 6090 Cargo Road at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport for the purposes of operating an air cargo facility. This ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Ordinance No. 1515-13 to exercise this option.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
