2022 LEGISLATIVE SUMMARY  
**NOPEC Energized Community Grant**

**DEPARTMENT:** Public Works

**ORDINANCE NO.:** 820-2022

**LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE:** An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Works to accept a grant in the amount of approximately \$250,000 from NOPEC, Inc. and to enter into contracts to implement energy related projects.

**FUNDING SOURCE:** NOPEC Energized Community Grant(s) (“NEC Grant(s)”) awarded by NOPEC Inc.

- Not a matching grant

**Grant Term** January 1, 2022 – December 31, 2022. The grant allows for disbursement of the grant funds to be submitted up until November 30, 2024

**Grant Amount** Approximately \$250,000

Note: Grant awards are based on the variable annual community choice aggregation (CCA) number of residential and small business enrollments in gas programs in the prior year (2021, in this instance).

**Program Description** This Grant will be used to enter into one or more public improvement, professional services, or standard or requirement contracts to implement energy efficiency and facility improvements for city facilities.

Contemplated projects include energy efficiency and City facility improvement projects, including but not limited to, installing HVAC improvements, building automation systems, LED lighting, insulation, possible solar photovoltaic implementations, electric vehicle charging stations, and other applicable energy projects.
