Subject: Authorizing the Directors of City Planning, Capital Projects, and Public

Works to apply for and accept a grant from the United States Department

of Transportation for the 2024 Safe Streets and Roads for All Grant.

Please prepare legislation authorizing the Directors of City Planning, Capital Projects, and Public Works to apply for and accept a grant in the amount of up to \$10,000,000 from the 2024 Safe Streets and Roads for All grant program. The grant will enable the city to advance the design of several corridors on its high injury network and implement supplemental planning and demonstration projects on other high crash segments. The legislation should also authorize the Director of City Planning, the Director of Capital Projects, and the Director of Public Works to employ one or more professional consultants and authorizing various written standard purchase and requirement contracts; determining the method of making the public improvements and of constructing safety improvements; and authorizing the directors to enter into one or more public improvement contracts for the making of the improvements.

Legislative Purpose: Authorizing the Directors of City Planning, Capital Projects,

and Public Works to apply for and accept a grant in the amount of up to \$10,000,000 of the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Safe Streets and Roads for All FY2024 Award dollars for the purpose of design services for Lee Road, Lorain Avenue, and East 93rd Street; for supplemental planning, design, and

quick-build demonstration projects for Kinsman Road, Superior Avenue, and Denison Avenue; and for project

management services.

Project Summary: The Directors of City Planning, Capital Projects, and Public

Works shall be authorized to apply for and accept a grant in

the amount of up to \$10,000,000 from the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Safe Streets and Roads for All FY2024 program for design services for Lee Road, Lorain Avenue, and East 93rd Street; for supplemental planning, design, and

quick-build demonstration projects for Kinsman Road, Superior Avenue, and Denison Avenue; and for project management services. Furthermore, the directors shall be authorized to employ one or more professional services consultants and authorized to enter into various written standard purchase and requirement contracts; to determine

the method of making the public improvements and constructing safety improvements; to enter into one or more public improvement contracts for the design, supplemental

planning, and installation of quick-build demonstration

projects.
