AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION
Withdrawing objection to the renewal of a D5 and D6 Liquor Permit at 1276 West 6th Street (3rd Floor Only) and 1280 West 6th Street & Patios and repealing Resolution No. 1033-2019 objecting to said renewal.

WHEREAS, this Council objected to the renewal of a D5 and D6 Liquor Permit to West 6th Street Partners, Inc., 1276 West 6th Street (3rd Floor Only) and 1280 West 6th Street & Patios, Cleveland, Ohio 44113, Permit No. 9555006 by Resolution No. 1033-2019, adopted by the Council on August 21, 2019; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to withdraw its objection to the above permit and consents to said permit; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That objection to the renewal of a D5 and D6 Liquor Permit to West 6th Street Partners, Inc., 1276 West 6th Street (3rd Floor Only) and 1280 West 6th Street & Patios, Cleveland, Ohio 44113, Permit No. 9555006 be and the same is hereby withdrawn and Resolution No. 1033-19, containing such objection, be and the same is hereby repealed and that this Council consents to the immediate permit thereof.

Section 2. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
