

Ordinance No. 785-2020

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Human Resources to apply for and accept grants from various agencies for the Wellness Works! Financial Wellness Program.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Human Resources is authorized to apply for and accept grants in the approximate aggregate amount of \$100,000 and any other funds that may become available during the grant term from The International Public Management Association for Human Resources (IPMA), the National Association of State Treasurers' Foundation (NASTF), and the Center for State and Local Government Excellence (SLGE) and Wells Fargo Foundation (collectively known as "State and Local Government Financial Wellness Partners") to conduct the Wellness Works! Financial Wellness Program; that the Director is authorized to file all papers and execute all documents necessary to receive the funds under the grants; and that the funds are appropriated for the purposes described in the legislative summary for the grant contained in the file described below.

Section 2. That the legislative summary for the grant, File No. 785-2020-A, made a part of this ordinance as if fully rewritten is approved in all respects and shall not be changed without additional legislative authority.

Section 3. That, unless expressly prohibited by the grant agreements, under division (B) of Section 108 of the Charter, purchases made under the grant agreements may be made through cooperative arrangements with other governmental agencies. The Director of Human Resources may sign all documents and do all things that are necessary to make the purchases, and may enter into one or more contracts with the vendors selected through that cooperative process. The contracts shall be paid from the fund or funds to which are credited any grant funds accepted under this ordinance.

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
