<b>Project Summary</b>	<p>In May 2024, the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (“U.S. EPA”) awarded the City a \$500,000 Brownfields Community-Wide Assessment Grant for brownfields inventory, assessment and redevelopment planning within the East 93<sup>rd</sup> Street Corridor Target Area (see attached map). There is no match required by this grant.</p> <p>To accept and expend the grant funds, the City must enter into a cooperative agreement with the U.S. EPA regarding the terms and conditions of the Brownfields Community-Wide Assessment Grant Program, including</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Purpose and allowable uses of the grant funds;</li> <li>• Effective date and term;</li> <li>• Scope of work authorized under the grant program;</li> <li>• Procurement standards and methods;</li> <li>• Administration, record-keeping and reporting required under the grant;</li> <li>• Certifications, warranties and indemnification; and</li> <li>• Other general terms.</li> </ul>
