AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE  
To amend Section 22 of Ordinance No. 194-2021,  
passed March 29, 2021, as amended, relating to  
compensation for various classifications.

FOR PASSAGE  
July 9, 2025

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the  
usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 22 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March 29, 2021,  
as amended by Ordinance No. 701-2023, passed June 5, 2023, and Ordinance No. 776-  
2023, passed July 12, 2023, is amended to read as follows:

Section 22. Cleveland Association of Rescue Employees (CARE), Local 1975. That salaries  
and compensation in the following classifications shall be fixed by the appointing authority in  
accordance with the schedule appearing after each classification:

Section 2. That existing Section 22 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March  
29, 2021, as amended by Ordinance No. 701-2023, passed June 5, 2023, and Ordinance  
No. 776-2023, passed July 12, 2023, is repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and,  
provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to  
Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by  
the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period  
allowed by law.
