## DEPARTMENT OF BUILDING AND HOUSING EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Ordinance No.

1286-17

**Description:** 

Authorizes the Director of Building and Housing to employ one or more professional consultants, computer software developers, and/or vendors to implement the E-Plan and Software Project; and authorizing the purchase by one or more contracts of materials, equipment, supplies and services needed to furnish and remodel the offices of the Building and Housing to implement the project.

**Analysis:** 

The Department of Building and Housing desires to upgrade their offices and technical systems from a paper-based submission of plan documents to electronically receive design documents, plans, and specifications to improve customer service and streamline the permit review process. This is an integral part of the E-Plan and Software Project, designed to implement this goal. The ordinance will result in an authorization to the Building and Housing Director to contract with computer software developers and consultants, and software vendors for the technical aspects of the process, including upgrades to existing software, new software, staff training and other services required to complete the process. The consultants, software developers, and vendors will be made by the Board of Control on the nomination of the Director of Building and Housing a list of qualified consultants. The ordinance also authorizes the Director of Building and Housing to contract with vendors for materials, equipment, supplies and services to upgrade and remodel the offices of the Building Department to accommodate the technical requirements and management of the workflow required for the new E-Plan and Software Project. This will include the purchase of furniture, computers, related equipment, and other services, purchased by the Commissioner of Purchases and Supplies.
