**Ohio Department of Health Lead Prevention Program  
Executive Summary & Budget  
For Ordinance Amendment**

**Purpose:**

This legislation authorizes the Director of Public Health to apply for and accept a grant from the Ohio Department of Public Health to increase the Department of Public Health's capacity to conduct public health lead investigations with the risk assessments for children with elevated blood lead levels; and to enter into an agreement with the J. A. Consultants, and authority to enter into contracts with various agencies, entities and individuals to implement the Lead Prevention Program.

This ordinance will continue to allow the Department of Public Health Division of Environment to do the following:

- 1) Contact the parent or guardian of the child to schedule a time and location to meet with the parent or guardian to complete the ODH public health investigation questionnaire.
- 2) Conduct an on-site public health lead investigation in accordance with rule 3701-30-07 of the OAC and policies and procedures provided by ODH.
- 3) Conduct target sampling in accordance with OAC rule 3701-30-07.
- 4) Issue a lead hazard control order in accordance with rule 3701-30-09 of the OAC
- 5) Review and approve extension request of the date by which a clearance examination must be passed in accordance with rule 3701-30-09 of the OAC
